Project Qualifications

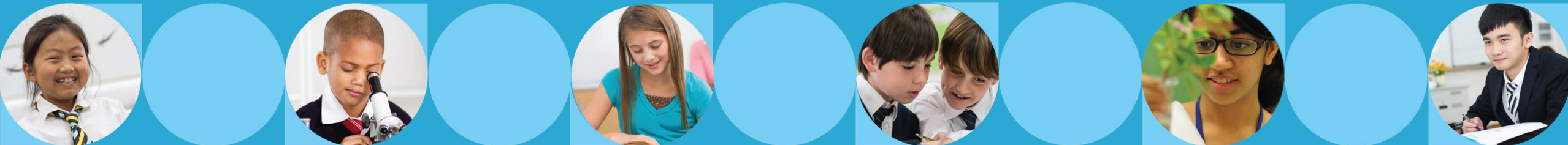
These are multi-disciplinary courses aimed at providing an opportunity for A-level students to produce a university-quality project in their chosen field.

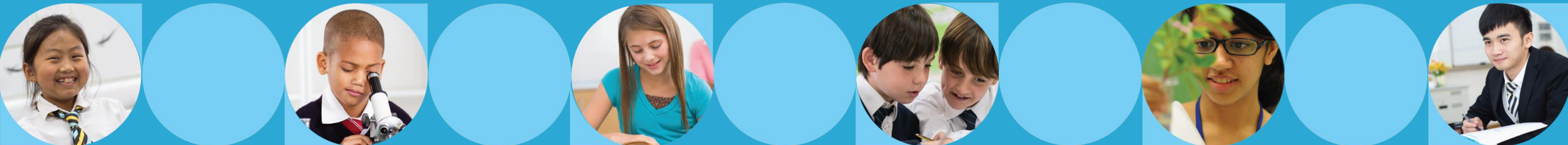

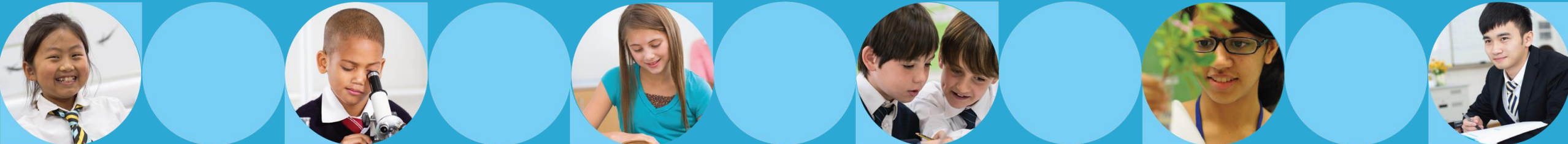

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

Cambridge school in China creates an evidence-based teaching and learning module to empower teachers and instructors

Improving education in classrooms begins with empowering teachers. When teachers develop the skills they need, they also develop their ability to help students learn. 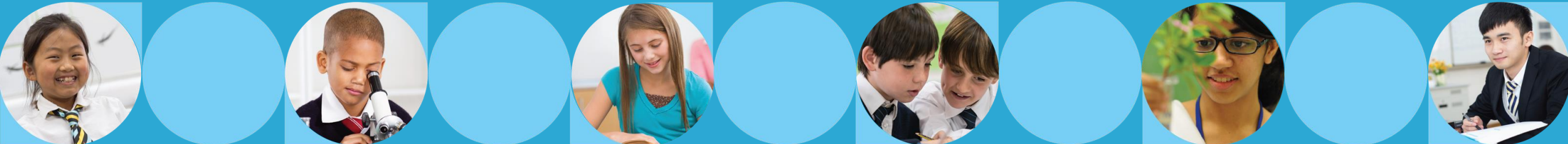
